A limited number of students, ranging from zero to four students (depending upon funds available), will be selected to receive funds from the earnings and income of the Fellowship Funds. These students will be selected upon the basis of their having exhibited unusually high intelligence, skills and abilities, which are not being fully utilized and developed because of the student's particular socio-economic background, or because of a lack of family or economic support. The funds from the Fellowship funds will be available to enhance the educational experience of the students.

TO THE TEACHER: Please complete this nomination form in support of a student candidate for Fellowship Funds in such a manner that the Application Committee may fairly consider his/her qualifications against other students nominated. Your thoughtful and thorough completion will assure your student the best possible chance for selection. It is also necessary that the parents/guardians of your nominated student complete a Parent Nomination Form. The nominating teacher will serve as a sponsor for nominated students. The teacher/sponsor would be available to assist parents in the completion of the form, if necessary. It is required that two letters of recommendation be submitted. These can be from the school principal, previous teachers, counselors, scout leaders, church personnel, etc. Additionally, a letter from the student nominated must be submitted in which he/she supports the desire for Funds. The two forms, the two letters of recommendation, and the student letter must be attached and returned to the nominating teacher.
